Ms. Balkema commented that at the December Board meeting, it was unclear at that time as to which investment management account funds should be transferred from for Cash Account needs for March 2025. After recent review of the investment accounts, Mr. Green and Ms. Balkema agreed to utilize \$1,550,000 from Private Equity and Private Credit distributions and to transfer \$200,000 from the Harvest Fund Advisors account to the Cash Account on March 3, 2025.
