request for Fire Fighter Christopher Moleski, based on the medical findings and reports that were presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Balkema and carried. Trustees thanked Mr. Moleski for his service and wished him well in his retirement.

Ms. Korzen next provided Trustees with an annual budget proposal. The figures on the proposed document represent the dollar amounts Trustees expect to be expended for the FYE 12/31/21. Ms. Korzen stated that a formal budget approved by Trustees annually is now a requirement under P.A. 314 and once approved by Trustees, will be available on the Retirement System's website. Mr. Balkema made the motion to approve the budget as written. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman VanderWall and carried.
