Trustees reviewed a Domestic Relations Order (DRO) for Mr. Martin P. Ogrodzinski. Ms. Korzen stated that a DRO has been filed to assign a portion of Mr. Ogrodzinski's retirement benefits to an alternate payee, April A. Ogrodzinski, in accordance with the Eligible Domestic Relations Order Act. The DRO has been reviewed by legal counsel and complies with the Police & Fire Retirement System plan provisions. The DRO will become part of Mr. Ogrodzinski's file and will be paid according to its provisions. The order was received and filed by the Chairman.

There were no public comments on items not on the agenda.

Ms. Korzen commented that at the December Board meeting, it was unclear at that time as to which investment management account funds should be transferred from for Cash Account needs for March 2021. After recent review of the investment accounts, Mr. Lindberg and the Executive Director agreed to transfer \$1,100,000 from the Wellington Management (equities) account to the Cash Account on March 1, 2021.
