Ms. Korzen commented that at the December Board meeting, it was unclear at that time as to which investment management account funds should be transferred from for Cash Account needs for March 2023. After recent review of the investment accounts, Wilshire and the Executive Director agreed to utilize \$300,000 from Private Equity/Private Credit distributions and to transfer \$1,075,000 from the NTAM account to the Cash Account on March 1, 2023.

Chairman Hawkins noted that former Vice Chairman Craig VanderWall's father, David, passed away recently and stated that the VanderWall family will be in the Board's thoughts and prayers.
