Mr. Balkema made the motion to nominate Mr. Michael Hawkins to serve as Chairman of the Board of Trustees for the year 2021; the motion was seconded by Mr. Moody and carried. Mr. Balkema made the motion to nominate Mr. Craig VanderWall to serve as Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees for the year 2021. The motion was seconded by Mr. Moody and carried. Mr. Mitchell made the motion to have Chairman Hawkins, Vice Chairman VanderWall, and Ms. Korzen sign the appropriate resolutions in order to act as authorized parties for the Police & Fire Retirement System. The motion was seconded by Mr. Moody and carried.

There were no public comments on items not on the agenda.

Ms. Korzen commented that at the December Board meeting, it was unclear which investment management account funds should be transferred from for Cash Account needs for February 2021. After recent review of the investment accounts, Mr. Born and the Executive Director agreed to transfer \$1,100,000 from the Wellington Management (equities) account to the Cash Account on February 1, 2021.
