MINUTES REGULAR MEETING MARCH 20, 2019 – 10:26 a.m. 233 East Fulton Street

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Hawkins. Other members present: Vice Chairman David Tryc, Mr. Martin Timkovich, Mr. Bill Butts, and Ms. Donijo DeJonge. Absent: Mr. Phillip Mitchell and Mr. Nathaniel Moody.

Also present: Ms. Peggy Korzen, Executive Director of the Retirement System and Mr. Thomas Michaud, Legal Advisor to the Board.

Vice Chairman Tryc made the motion to excuse the absences of Mr. Mitchell and Mr. Moody. The motion was seconded by Mr. Butts and carried.

Ms. Korzen recommended, and Mr. David Lindberg of Wilshire Associates agreed, making the transfers as follows:

Ms. Korzen presented the Public Act 314 Asset Analysis showing a market value of \$400,880,155 on January 31, 2019. The report was received and filed by the Chairman. (Analysis found on page

Ms. Korzen commented that there are four potential disability retiree re-exams this year. Chairman Hawkins suggested going into closed session to discuss the issues surrounding the potential re-examinations. Vice Chairman Tryc made the motion to go into closed session to discuss the potential disability retiree re-exams, as this contains information that is exempt from the Freedom of Information Act and is also medically privileged, and to include Ms. Korzen, Mr. Michaud, and Ms. Balkema. The motion was seconded by Mr. Timkovich and carried. Roll call vote: yeas: 5, nays: 0. Following Trustee discussion, Vice Chairman Tryc made the motion to have the medical records for Ms. Rose Hockey, Mr. William Leach, Mr. Jason Thompson, and Ms. Kathleen Wildfong reviewed by one of the Board's physicians and proceed with a re-examination if warranted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Timkovich and carried. Mr. Butts added that the physicians should be asked to indicate (if they are able) the period of time after which they feel the retiree should have their medical records reviewed again or have an examination; Trustees agreed.

There were no public comments on items not on the agenda.
