MINUTES REGULAR MEETING SEPTEMBER 16, 2020 – 10:15 a.m. VIA ONLINE CONFERENCE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Hawkins. Other members present: Vice Chairman Craig VanderWall, Mr. Philip Balkema, Mr. Phillip Mitchell, Ms. Donijo DeJonge, Mr. Nathaniel Moody, and Mr. Robert Veenstra.

Also present: Ms. Peggy Korzen, Executive Director of the Retirement System, Mr. Thomas Michaud, Legal Advisor to the Board, and Ms Lisa Balkema, Retirement Services Specialist.

There were no public comments regarding agenda items.

Moved by Mr. Balkema and seconded by Mr. Veenstra, the following administrative items were approved by the Board of Trustees:

Ms. Korzen recommended, and Wilshire Associates agreed, making the transfers as follows:

Ms. Korzen presented the Public Act 314 Asset Analysis showing a market value of \$433,332,522 on July 31, 2020. The report was received and filed by the Chairman. (Analysis found on page

There were no public comments on items not on the agenda.

Ms. Korzen noted that the Annual Accounting for the General Retirement System for the period 07/01/19 - 06/30/20 was ready to be reviewed. She noted that it was decided by Trustees to review the Annual Accountings of both retirement systems at the same time each year, and therefore a committee should be established to review the Police & Fire Annual Accounting for the year ending 12/31/2019. She commented that beginning with this annual accounting and going forward, the annual accountings will be viewed electronically through the SharePoint site; if Trustees need to consult any additional files, she will arrange for that. Chairman Hawkins and Vice Chairman VanderWall volunteered to serve. Ms. Korzen will coordinate the review of accounting and the Trustees will report their findings to the Board at a future Board meeting.

Ms. Korzen noted that the term of office for Mr. Craig VanderWall will be expiring the first Monday in 2021. The election process has begun and nominating petitions are due in the Retirement Systems office by September 25th. Vice Chairman VanderWall has been the only person to submit a nominating petition thus far. She will keep Trustees informed of the progress in the election process.
