# Summary Report of Plan Operations/Expenses

How much does it cost to manage the Police & Fire Retirement System? For the period 01/01/22 - 12/31/22, it cost the Retirement System approximately \$2.4 million. Most of this amount (\$1,771,342) was for investment manager fees. The balance of the expenses, \$674,986, paid for asset custody, auditors, actuaries, attorneys, independent medical evaluations, office rent, staff salaries and training. The costs to run the plan are approximately 0.53% (53 basis points) of the market value of assets. All fees and expenses are paid in cash, as the Plan does not employ soft dollar arrangements. Audits, annual accountings, and actuarial valuations may be reviewed at the Retirement Systems Office.

# State of Michigan Tax Changes

On March 7, 2023, the Governor signed into law Public Act 4 of 2023 ("PA 4") (formerly House Bill 4001) which phases in a state income tax reduction for retirees over the course of four years. Please note that if you spend the winter months elsewhere, you must notify us in writing when you go and again when you come back to avoid your pension correspondence being returned.
